FROM THE PASTOR

**YOU NEVER KNOW
WHEN
IT'S GOING TO BE
EASTER!**

"When is Easter this year?" is a question I frequently hear. Its date "floats" - occurring the first Sunday after the first full moon after the vernal equinox (the first day of spring).

Easter Sunday, March 27, will soon be upon us. Yet Easter is not something that one can limit to a day on the calendar.

The Bible tell us *'On the Road to Emmaus, Jesus himself came up and walked with a couple of disciples - yet they did not recognize him. It was in the routine task of sharing a meal they finally recognized Jesus.'* Jesus comes up and walks with us, but something keeps us from knowing who it is. Perhaps we don't expect Jesus to be with us here and now, or perhaps we're caught up in our own concerns and activities. Have you ever felt the darkness of a problem overshadowing you like Good Friday - when hopelessness filled the air?

Yet, like the dawn of Easter there comes a Spirit, a strength, a friend, an answer, something that you hadn't noticed before - breathing new life back into you. Yes, right here in our midst of our everyday tasks, Christ is transforming you, the whole world and me. It doesn't matter what day it is, a spring filled day in late March or a summer day in June, "Suddenly, it's Easter!" as God's presence fills you and the world with new hope and possibilities.

Remember your "Easters," those times you have felt Christ especially close to you - give thanks to God for them. Let them remind you that Christ is with you always - especially today. Consider how you can share the "Easter" spirit with someone else, through your smile, your listening, your comforting words, your friendship, your help, sharing your talents and resources... your faith and prayers.

of God's love, sharing the Good News of Easter, and helping others experience the miracle of God's transforming love in their lives.

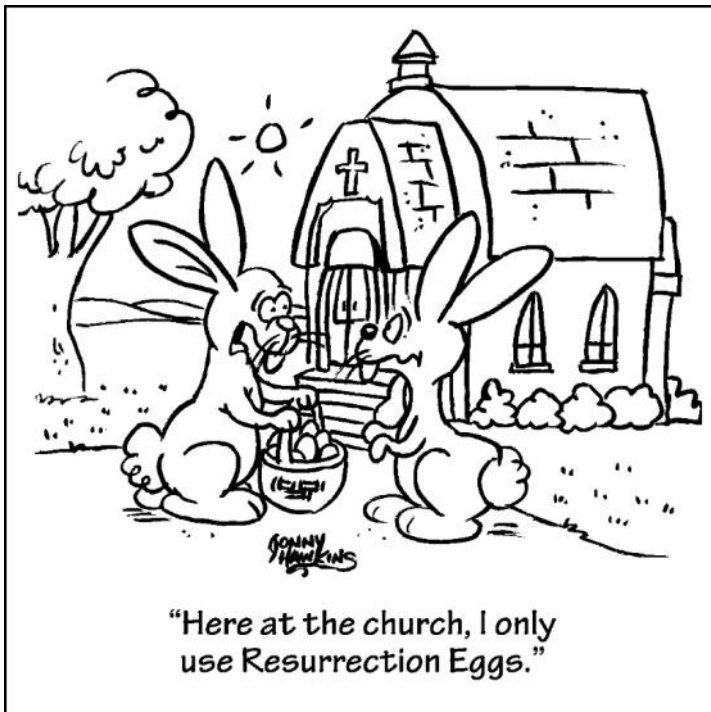
We give thanks for Judy's life and that she is now with Jesus in life eternal. We pray God's love and support be with her family and friends.
